Louise Peters is presently serving as the Vicar at St. James Cathedral, Toronto. Prior to this appointment, she served as the Executive Director of Sorrento Retreat and

Conference Centre and had the pleasure of working with a team of people who provided hospitality, community and faith formation, youth leadership development in a beautiful 24 acre setting in the Shuswap Lake area of British Columbia. Louise served as the Dean of St. Paul's Cathedral, Kamloops BC for 12 years, and prior to that ministry was Co-Rector with her husband at St. Timothy's 100 Mile House BC. Ordained in 1985 in the Diocese of Huron, Louise served in that diocese at St Paul's Cathedral, London Ontario as the Assistant to the Dean; as Chaplain at the University of Western Ontario, and Huron College; and incumbent of St James, Ingersoll Ontario. Throughout her ministry, she has offered Spiritual Direction and led retreats, quiet days and discernment sessions. Nothing makes her heart sing more than to sit with others and engage in scripture through an inquisitive lens that permits each person in the circle to be a theologian.
